Deep ruby core with a hint of purple lingering in the rim. Vibrant red and black fruits, rosemary and broken terracotta aromas. Full-bodied, weighty dark fruits, but the palate is driven by savoury olive tapenade, wakame and graphite minerality. A feeling of darkness and depth, brooding and intense. The tannins are like fine chalk, giving length. Many years of enjoyment here
